

Biology Resources at the Cameron Library



Books - Search in Cameron University Library's Catalog

<http://libinfosource.cameron.edu/>

Open the Library's homepage and select **Books and More (Catalog)** to find books and items located in the library. Search the catalog by title, author, or keyword to find the location, call number, and status of books and other items. Biological resources are available in the Reference section and the Serials section on the 2nd floor.

The call numbers for Biology will begin with **QH, QM, QP, and QR**.

Articles in Journals and Magazines - Search the Databases <http://www.cameron.edu/library/databaseoff.html>

Open the Library's homepage and select **Articles (Databases)**. Select the box for **Health Sciences** or **Science and Math**. You can also select a database by name, as listed below in the boxes. Enter keywords (main concepts) to begin searching for articles in the subscription databases.

Health Source: Nursing/Academic Edition: (EBSCO) Full-text and abstracts; can be combined with other EBSCO searches. **Specializes** in scholarly journals associated with the Health Sciences.

Health Source: Consumer Edition: (EBSCO) Full-text and abstracts; can be combined with other EBSCO searches. **Specializes** in main-stream journals associated with the Health Sciences.

PubMed Central: (U.S. National Library of Medicine) Full-text articles that focus on Biomedical issues.

Medline: (EBSCO) Abstracts only, but can link to available full-text; can be combined with other EBSCO searches. Specializes in Medical issues.

Biological Abstracts: (EBSCO) Abstracts only, but can link to available full-text; can be combined with other EBSCO searches. Indexes 4,000+ Biology journals.

SAGE Premier: Complete full-text from high-end scholarly journals covering all topics.

JSTOR: Complete full-text for various scholarly topics including the Health Sciences.

Academic Search Premier: (EBSCO) Full-text and abstracts; can be combined with other EBSCO searches. Includes many full-text Medical journals.

Wilson Omnifile Full Text Select: (EBSCO) Complete full-text covering all topics; can be combined with other EBSCO searches.

Films on Demand: Over 6,000 streaming videos covering multiple topics and issues, including Biology.

Credo Reference: Full-text information/entries from a variety of encyclopedias and dictionaries. Great alternative to Google!

Anatomy Kits



Cameron Library now has **Anatomy kits**, including **skulls, upper and lower limbs, heart models, and human vertebrae**. They are located in the textbook room 118 on the first floor.

Government Resources

Cameron Library also provides links to various **.gov resources**, such as the **Centers for Disease Control** and **The National Institutes of Health**. Just click on the *Government Resources* page in the *Research box* on the library's homepage, then click **Health**.
