Minutes from the meeting on January 12, 2017
Ross Hall 228**

The minutes from the November 30, 2016, meeting were approved.

Dana gave the committee an update on Plan 2023 preparations. The website with information-gathering surveys will go live on February 2nd. Many listening sessions will be held between February and April. Surveys for different populations (faculty, staff, students, community members, etc.) will be developed.

Dana asked the committee members to help brainstorm ways to develop the section of the surveys that deals with Cameron's Mission Statement and Core Value Statements. The members discussed the purpose of a mission statement and the guiding principles used when developing mission statements. Two of the goals of this section of the survey are (1) to see if the Cameron community thinks the Mission Statement and Core Value Statements are still reflective of our campus goals and (2) to see if CU's constituents think our collective actions reflect the current stated mission and values.
