4. Official transcript of college course work, translated into English.
5. Six months of current bank statements (or bank letter) indicating availability of funds to cover all tuition, fees, and living expenses for a minimum of one academic year.
6. Affidavit of Financial Support (affidavit form)
7. A copy of the page (or pages) of your passport that indicate your complete name, country of citizenship, passport number, and passport expiration date.
8. Official copy of **TOEFL** (Test of English as a Foreign Language) test score report of 213 or higher (computer-based test), 550 or higher (paper-based test), or 79-80 (Internet-based test). Alternatively, an official copy of **IELTS** (International English Language Testing System) test score report of 6.5 or higher.

United States Citizen and Immigration Services (USCIS) regulations require documentation that sufficient financial resources are available to meet a student’s prospective educational and living expenses while in the U.S. Therefore, Cameron University requires a guarantee of financial resources from each applicant who expects to obtain or maintain F-1 (student) visa status. Applicants are required to submit documentation that shows financial resources that **equal or exceed one year of expenses** for the program of study they are interested in pursuing. **A Certificate of Eligibility (USCIS Form I-20) will not be issued until this information is provided.**

This estimate is based upon **9** semester hours each semester for **graduate studies**; this is the average number of hours taken by international students. (NOTE: graduates are required by USCIS to complete 9 credit hours each semester, for the Fall and Spring semesters. International students are free to take more than 9 credit hours per semester and they may also take courses in the summer.) **Housing cost** is calculated at the highest room and meal plan. The cost estimate below **does not include costs for tuition, books, fees, lodging, meals, or other expenses for the summer months.**

Scholarships and on-campus jobs available to international students are very limited. International students should not rely on scholarship funds or work-study jobs to finance their educational costs. International students may not apply for scholarships or work-study jobs until they are admitted to CU.

The amounts listed below **are subject to change without notice.** Historically, total costs have increased on an average of 1-5% each year. Students can expect adjustments in the amounts listed on the Certificates of Eligibility (I-20) which will reflect estimates of the possible increases in the upcoming year.
