

## Comanche County Retired Educators Association \$1,000 Scholarship

The Comanche County Retired Educators Association offers to students who are an academic major and have 90 or more hours completed by the beginning of the academic school year a \$1,000 scholarship. Post-baccalaureate students seeking teacher education are eligible to apply.

### **The Process**

Students are to submit a 300 word essay on why you believe you should be awarded the scholarship and explain your career objectives. You are to include your grade point average; and list any stipends, scholarships, or sources of support for your education. Two letters of reference and a current transcript are required.

Applications are to be submitted to the office of the Director of Teacher Education, Nance Boyer, Room 1023, no later than MARCH 30 of the current academic year. A scholarship committee composed of members of the Comanche County Retired Educators Association will make the final selection after an interview with 3 or more applicants. The winner will make appropriate remarks at the luncheon in June of the Comanche County Retired Educators Association.

The Office of Financial Aid at Cameron University, on behalf of the Comanche County Retired Educators Association, will issue checks for \$500 each semester of the academic year to assist in tuition and fee payments.
