## Financial Guarantee

Cameron University – Office of International Admissions – Lawton, OK 73505

United States Citizen and Immigration Services (USCIS) regulations require documentation that sufficient financial resources are available to meet a student’s prospective educational and living expenses while in the U.S. Therefore, Cameron University requires a guarantee of financial resources from each applicant who expects to obtain or maintain F-1 (student) visa status. Applicants are required to submit documentation that shows financial resources that **equal or exceed one year of expenses** for the program of study they are interested in pursuing. **A Certificate of Eligibility (USCIS Form I-20) will not be issued until this information is provided.**

This estimate is based upon **9** semester hours each semester for **graduate studies**; this is the average number of hours taken by international students. (NOTE: graduates are required by USCIS to complete 9 credit hours each semester, for the Fall and Spring semesters. International students are free to take more than 9 credit hours per semester and they may also take courses in the summer.) **Housing cost** is calculated at the highest room and meal plan. The cost estimate below **does not include costs for tuition, books, fees, lodging, meals, or other expenses for the summer months.**

Scholarships and on-campus jobs available to international students are very limited. **International students should not rely on scholarship funds or work-study jobs to finance their educational costs.** International students may not apply for scholarships or work-study jobs until they are admitted to CU.

The amounts listed below **are subject to change without notice.** Historically, total costs have increased on an average of 1-5% each year. Students can expect adjustments in the amounts listed on the Certificates of Eligibility (I-20) which will reflect estimates of the possible increases in the upcoming year.
