1. Minutes from the February 26 electronic meeting were approved.
2. Program and course modifications
 - 2.1. School of Liberal Arts
 - 2.1.1. Department of History and Government
 - 2.1.1.1. HIST 4773—change in prerequisites. There was a typing error on the Curriculum Request cover page that was immediately fixed. The request from the History Department was typed correctly. After this typing error on the Curriculum Request cover page was fixed, the change in prerequisites was unanimously approved.
