This Associate of Science degree program is offered in cooperation with the University of Oklahoma College of Nursing. To be eligible to apply for admission to the OU baccalaureate nursing program, graduates of this program must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale, a science GPA of 2.5, and OU will not accept anything below a "C" in all courses. Associate of Science graduates who meet the stated requirements will be eligible to be considered for admission to the University of Oklahoma College of Nursing's baccalaureate nursing program.

NOTE: A student planning for admission to a nursing program at another college or university should consult an advisor at that institution each semester to get current requirements.
