

Valree Fletcher Wynn Scholarship

The Valree Fletcher Wynn Scholarship is open to all high school students who wish to pursue a degree at Cameron University. Applicants must demonstrate evidence of strong academic performance and leadership ability. Preference will be given to students who are economically disadvantaged or members of underrepresented groups, as well as to those electing a major in English. The award covers all tuition costs for the recipient's first year at Cameron University.

In order to be eligible, applicants must have been admitted to Cameron University and be residents of the state of Oklahoma.

Applicants must have a minimum high school GPA of 3.0 on a four point scale and must have a minimum composite ACT score of 20.

Scholarship is non-renewable.

Only complete applications will be accepted. Applicants must submit a packet containing each of the following items.

- Cover Sheet
- One-page essay describing the applicant's leadership abilities and explaining why the applicant believes that he/she is deserving of the scholarship
- Resume of high school activities
- Three letters of recommendation (at least one must be from a high school teacher or counselor)
- High school transcript with ACT scores
