Estimated Costs per Academic Year **for Undergraduate International Students**

The *approximate* cost to attend Cameron University for *one academic year* (one academic year includes the Fall and Spring Semesters) is outlined in the following paragraphs. This estimate does not reflect any tuition, fees, lodging, meal, or other expenses for the summer months. You will need to allow money for returning home or living in the United States during the summer (mid-May to mid-August).

This estimate is not a fixed cost; it is merely a tool for you to use to budget your expenses for your first year at Cameron. *Each student's circumstances will be somewhat different, resulting in different living expenses.* If you take more or fewer classes each semester, your tuition amounts will vary. If you have a roommate or live off-campus, you can expect to pay different expenses for lodging and meals.

The cost of medical care in the U.S. is very high. Even a short visit to the doctor can be very expensive. All international students are required to enroll in the Student Health Insurance Plan. The insurance premium will be automatically assessed to your university account. In order for international students to waive coverage, students must complete and submit a waiver form with proof of comparable coverage prior to the waiver deadline date after enrolling in classes at Cameron.

International students are required by the U.S. Bureau of Citizenship and Immigration Services (US-CIS) to be enrolled "full-time." At Cameron, full-time enrollment for undergraduates is satisfied by completion of a minimum of 12 credit hours each Fall and Spring semester; graduate students must complete 9 hours per semester. You are not required to attend school during the summer, but you may attend the 8-week summer session.

There are a variety of lodging and meal plans available on campus, and there are many options for living away from campus. **We strongly recommend that you spend at least your first semester on campus.** This allows you to become familiar with life, people, customs, and culture in the city of Lawton, in the state of Oklahoma, and in the U.S.A., as well as time to adjust to student life at Cameron University. Students should not arrive without prearranged housing.

*Estimated** Costs Per Academic Year (two semesters) for Undergraduate International Students (Excludes costs for summer)*

Tuition and Fees **\$ 1,198.00**

This amount represents an “average” course load of 30 semester hours taken over the fall and spring semesters. Some international students choose to take more semester hours per year in order to complete their degree requirements more quickly. They do this by attending the summer session or taking larger course loads during the fall or spring semester.

International Student Fee - \$25.00 per semester) **\$ 50.00**

Health Insurance **\$ 80.00**

Cameron University carries a health insurance plan and automatically enrolls all international students upon arrival.

Estimated costs for transportation, clothing, telephone, entertainment, laundry, leisure, etc.

Meals and Lodging ***

Also known as “Room and Board.” This is calculated at the highest cost for meals and lodging. Your amount could be less or more, depending on your lifestyle.

Students should not arrive without prearranged housing. The \$200 deposit, initial payment, and housing application (online) are required in advance to reserve rooms. Housing reserves rooms on a first-come, first-serve basis, and usually fills to capacity quickly. Any advanced payment for housing will be refunded or deferred until the following semester in the event that the student is denied a student visa.
