**** Elementary Education majors must demonstrate foreign language proficiency at the novice-high level for certification. (Grade of "C" or better in specified foreign language course, or "S" on Language proficiency exam).

Teacher Education admission requirements:

- A grade of "C" or better in ENGL 1113, ENGL 1213, COMM 1113, MATH 1513 or higher, HIST 1483 or 1493, PS 1113 and 2 Humanities.
- A grade of "S" in EDUC 1800.
- Concurrent enrollment OR a grade of "C" or better in EDUC 3003, EDUC 3733, and Science (Biology or Physical Science). **NOTE:** Students concurrently enrolled in EDUC 3003 must provide a grade check of "C" or better. If the student receives a grade below "C" or a grade of "I", the admission to Teacher Education will be revoked, any enrollments in restricted classes for the upcoming semester will be dropped, and the student will have to reapply for admission.
- Passing scores on the Nelson Denny reading test (taken during EDUC 3003) and OGET.
- Maintain a GPA of 2.5 at all times.
- Passing score on EDUC 3003 lesson plan rubric.
- Three positive recommendation forms.
- Satisfactory completion of entry interview.
