Application Requirements: (\*NOTE: Only complete applications will be considered)

1. Candidate must submit a three-hundred-word essay explaining the following:
  - a) his/her goals as a teacher;
  - b) his/her career objectives;
  - c) his/her reasons why he/she should receive this award.
2. Candidate must submit a current college transcript and GPA
3. Candidate must submit two letters of recommendation from former or current college professors.
4. Candidate must list any other awards, scholarships, or stipends received toward is/her education.

Process:

Application should be submitted to Barbara Pickthorn, Cameron Library, Room 120, by July 30, 2010. At that time, the members of the Scholarship Committee of the Alpha Eta Chapter of **ALPHA DELTA KAPPA** will select a recipient who will be invited to attend the September meeting of the organization to meet with the members.

The scholarship in the amount of \$500 will be awarded by check made out to **CAMERON UNIVERSITY** with the name and social security number of the recipient clearly marked on it so that the amount will be credited to the recipient's tuition account.
