Application Deadline is September 10.

Winners will be selected by members of the CUAA Board of Directors and announced on September 17, at which time the artist may pick up supplies from Cameron University. Artist is required to transport panels to and from campus and must provide own space to paint off-campus.

Murals must be brought to the Fine Arts Courtyard on October 19 between the times of 8:00 am to 2:00 p.m.

Installation will occur the week of October 19, with a community event on October 22 where we will introduce the artists.
