

# Cameron University Concurrent Enrollment

## **CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

Concurrently enrolled students who are admitted to Cameron University must satisfy requirements for high school graduation no later than the spring semester of their senior year, meet course placement requirements and meet the following criteria:

## **Accredited High School:**

• Minimum 20  $ACT^1$  composite score (SAT  $1020^2/940^3$ ) OR unweighted 3.0 high school GPA and rank top 50% of graduating class.

## **Home School or Unaccredited High School:**

- Minimum 20 ACT composite score (SAT 1020<sup>2</sup>/940<sup>3</sup>).
- Completed high school coursework to be equivalent to an individual classified as a junior or senior at an accredited high school.

### **Required Documents:**

- 1. Application for admission online at www.cameron.edu/apply
- 2. Official ACT scores
- 3. Official high school transcript
- 4. Concurrent Enrollment Verification Form (Each Semester)

When all required documentation has been verified and the student has been officially admitted, the student may schedule an appointment to enroll by calling the Academic Advisement Center at 580-581-6741 or by emailing <a href="mailto:advisingcenter@cameron.edu">advisingcenter@cameron.edu</a>. #### **COSTS**

Students are responsible for all costs including books, parking permit, student I.D., and other associated costs and fees. Note: There are additional charges for online courses (\$50 per credit hour). Example: A typical online course generates 3 credit hours. 3 credit hours multiplied by \$50 is \$150.00.

The following tuition waivers are available:

#### **Senior Merit Tuition Waiver:**

- Minimum 20 ACT composite score OR unweighted 3.0 high school GPA and rank top 50% of graduating class
- 18 credit hours of tuition per year (Summer prior to senior year, Fall, Spring)
- Maintain 2.0 college cumulative GPA

# Junior Merit Tuition Waiver: 4

- Minimum 20 ACT composite score OR unweighted 3.0 high school GPA and rank top 50% of graduating class
- 9 credit hours of tuition per year (Summer prior to junior year, Fall, Spring)
- Maintain 2.0 college cumulative GPA
- 1 Anywhere ACT scores are mentioned in this document, equivalent Pre-ACT, Residual ACT, PSAT or SAT scores may be substituted
- 2 This score is valid on SATs and PSATs administered on or after March 5, 2016. This score is based on College Board's Concordance Table that was published on May 9, 2016. It is subject to change

## **CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT ACADEMIC INFORMATION**

A junior or senior in high school may enroll in a combined number of high school and college courses per semester not to exceed a full-time college workload of 19 semester credit hours. For purposes of calculating workload, one-half high school unit shall be equivalent to three semester credit hours of college work. Non-academic high school units are excluded from workload calculation.

To help insure that the student possesses the skills necessary to be successful in college, a concurrent student must have a minimum 19 ACT score in English, Math, or Science to enroll in the corresponding subject area. A minimum ACT score of 19 in Reading is required to enroll in any other collegiate course. Some courses may have additional requirements. Additionally, placement requirements for general education courses must be met. Concurrent students may not enroll in remedial coursework.

To continue concurrent enrollment in subsequent semesters, concurrently enrolled students must maintain a college cumulative GPA of 2.0 or above on a 4.0 scale. If a concurrent student's college cumulative GPA falls below 2.0, the student will be permanently disqualified for concurrent enrollment for all future semesters. Additionally, concurrent students must provide a current class schedule to Cameron University detailing all courses they are enrolled in at their high school and any vocational/technical schools prior to enrolling concurrently each semester.
