

Cameron University Concurrent Enrollment

CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Concurrently enrolled students who are admitted to Cameron University must satisfy requirements for high school graduation no later than the spring semester of their senior year, meet course placement requirements and meet the following criteria:

Accredited High School:

• Minimum 19 ACT¹ composite score OR unweighted 3.0 high school GPA

Home School or Unaccredited High School:

- Minimum 19 ACT composite score
- Completed high school coursework to be equivalent to an individual classified as a junior or senior at an accredited high school

Required Documents:

- 1. Application for admission online at <u>www.cameron.edu/apply</u>
- 2. Official ACT scores
- 3. Official high school transcript
- 4. Concurrent Enrollment Verification Form (Each Semester)

When all required documentation has been verified and the student has been officially admitted, the student may schedule an appointment to enroll by calling the Academic Advisement Center at 580-581-6741 or by emailing <u>advisingcenter@cameron.edu</u>. COSTS

University tuition and mandatory fee rates can be found at <u>www.cameron.edu/info/schedules/tuition</u>. Students are responsible for all costs including books, parking permit, student I.D., and other associated costs and fees.

The following tuition waivers are available:

Senior Merit Tuition Waiver:

- Minimum 19 ACT composite score OR unweighted 3.0 high school GPA
- 18 credit hours of tuition per year (Summer prior to senior year, Fall, Spring)
- Maintain 2.0 college cumulative GPA

Junior Merit Tuition Waiver:

- Minimum 19 ACT composite score OR unweighted 3.0 high school GPA
- 9 credit hours of tuition per year (Summer prior to junior year, Fall, Spring)
- Maintain 2.0 college cumulative GPA

1 Anywhere ACT scores are mentioned in this document, equivalent Pre-ACT, Residual ACT, PSAT or SAT scores may be substituted

CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT ACADEMIC INFORMATION

A junior or senior in high school may enroll in a combined number of high school and college courses per semester not to exceed a full-time college workload of 19 semester credit hours. For purposes of calculating workload, one-half high school unit shall be equivalent to three semester credit hours of college work. Non-academic high school units are excluded from workload calculation.

To help ensure that the student possesses the skills necessary to be successful in college, a concurrent student must meet certain minimum qualifications to enroll in entry level courses. Minimums for commonly enrolled courses are listed below. Some courses may have additional requirements. Additionally, placement requirements for general education courses must be met. Concurrent students may not enroll in remedial coursework.

To continue concurrent enrollment in subsequent semesters, concurrently enrolled students must maintain a college cumulative GPA of 2.0 or above on a 4.0 scale. If a concurrent student's college cumulative GPA falls below 2.0, the student will be permanently disqualified from concurrent enrollment for all future semesters at any Oklahoma State System institution. Additionally, concurrent students must provide Cameron University with a new concurrent verification form prior to enrolling concurrently each semester. The form must include a current class schedule detailing all courses they are enrolled in at their high school and any vocational/ technical schools.

RECOMMENDED GENERAL EDUCATION CLASSES

Updated ACT scores received after a course begins will not be considered for that semester.


