



Affidavit of Financial Support

United States Citizen and Immigration Services (USCIS) regulations require documentation that sufficient financial resources are available to meet a student's prospective educational and living expenses while in the United States. Therefore, Cameron University requires a guarantee of financial resources from each applicant who expects to obtain or maintain F-1 visa status. Applicants are required to submit documentation that shows financial resources equal to or exceeding one year of expenses for the program of study they are interested in pursuing. The Form I-20 will not be issued until this information is provided.

All financial aid sources – scholarships, loans, and on-campus employment – are small in number, of limited monetary value, highly competitive, and should not be relied upon for financial support.

I understand the expenses listed at <http://www.cameron.edu/admissions/international/tuitionandfees> are cost estimates.
