- 3. Connection to the educational mission of Cameron University is clear
- 4. Proposal contains well-defined outcomes
- 5. Proposal contains itemized budget
- 6. Reasonable expectation that the project can be completed within one year and with the resources requested
- 7. Project is of lasting and continuing benefit to CU and presents plans for enhancement and sustainability beyond grant period
- 8. Wide applicability (university-wide, interdisciplinary, department-wide)
- 9. High cost/benefit ratio
- 10. Benefit beyond the individual is specified
- 11. Attention to updating current practice or addressing future trend is described
