CREDIT TO CONTACT HOURS RATIO**

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Credit to Contact hour ratios for RAD courses are as follows:

Didactic (Lecture): 1 credit hours = 16 contact hours

Lab: 1 credit hour = 40 contact hours

Clinical: 1 credit hour = 82.5 contact hours

Lecture 1 CH = 16 hours (1 hour/week/CH for 16 weeks) (1 faculty load hour)

Lab 1 CH = 40 hours (2.5 hours/week/CH for 15 weeks) (1.875 faculty load hours)

Clinical 1 CH = 82.5 hours (5.5 hours/week/CH for 15 weeks) (2.25 faculty load hours)

The evaluation of the equivalency of general education courses will be aligned with the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education found at www.okhighered.org/transfer-students and determined by CU registrar.

The CU Registrar office makes the initial determination of course transferability based on the transferring institution accreditation and the comparability of course work for the Associate of Applied Science Degree in Radiologic Technology. Course equivalents are subject to change without advance notice.
