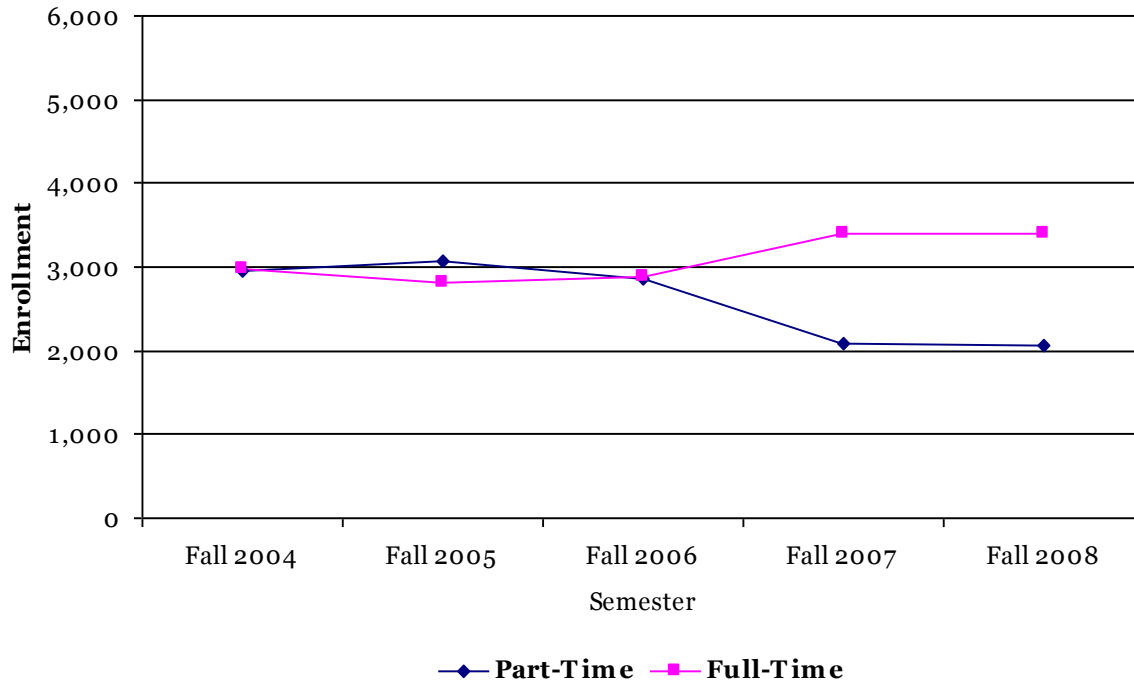

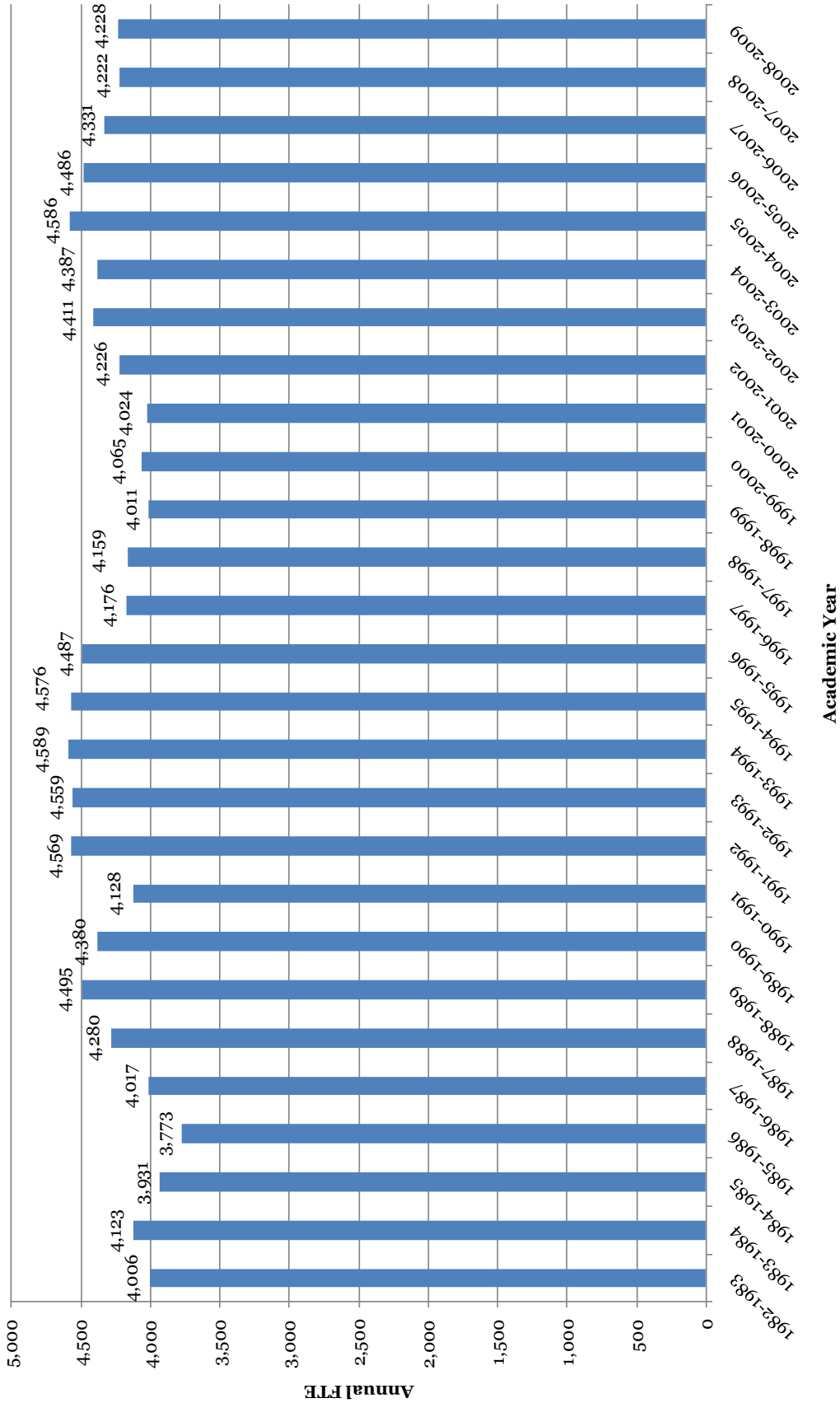


Historic Full-Time & Part-Time Enrollment



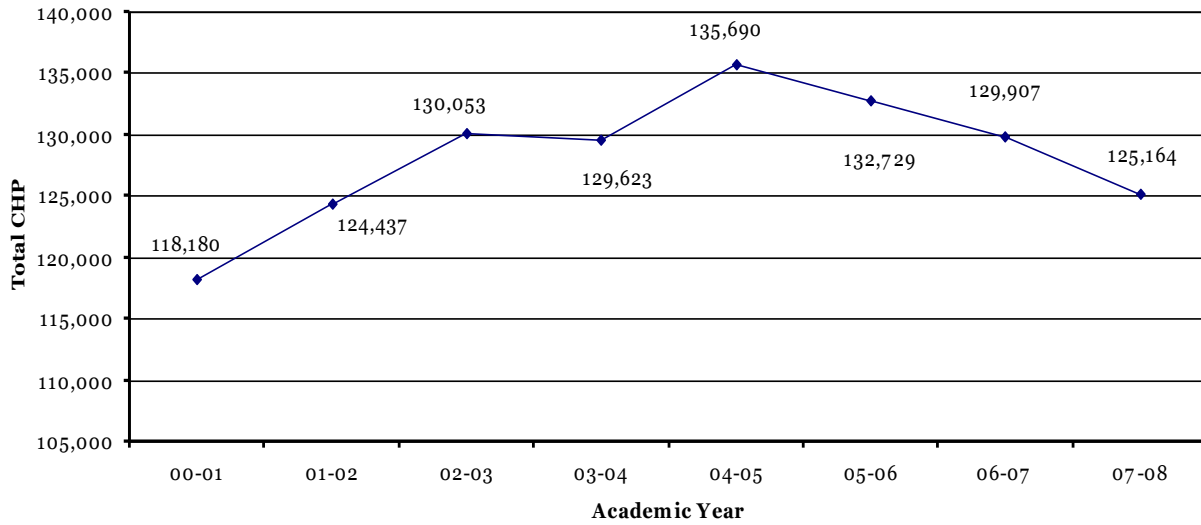


Annual Full-Time Equivalent Enrollment



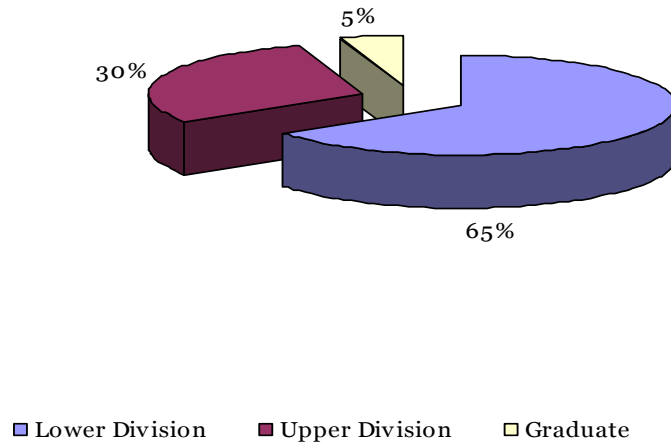

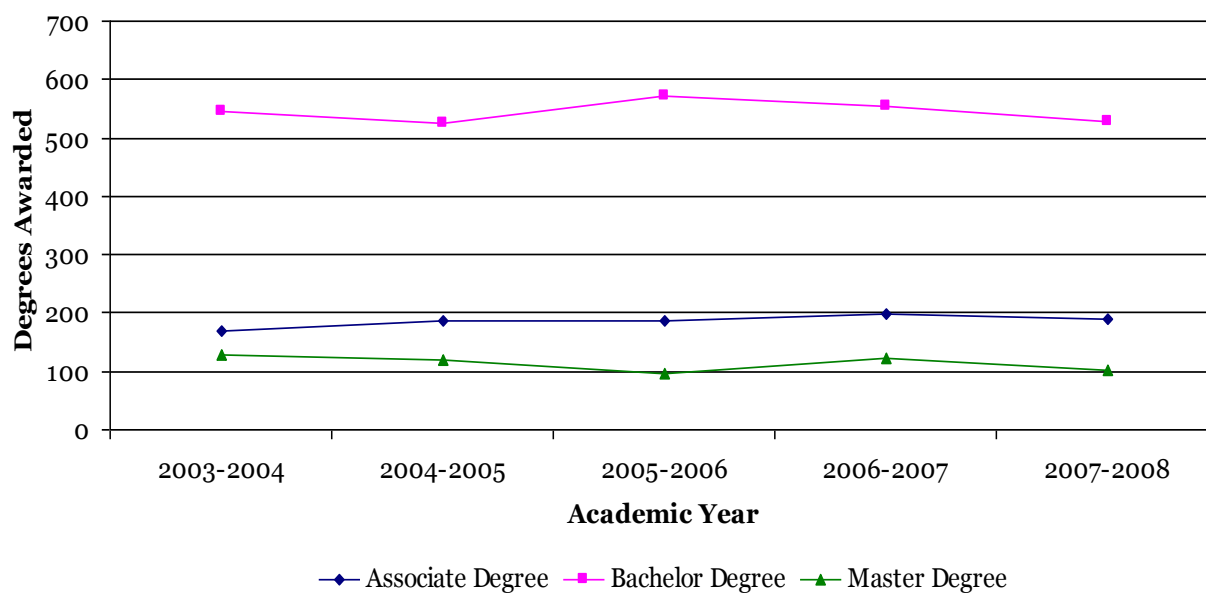

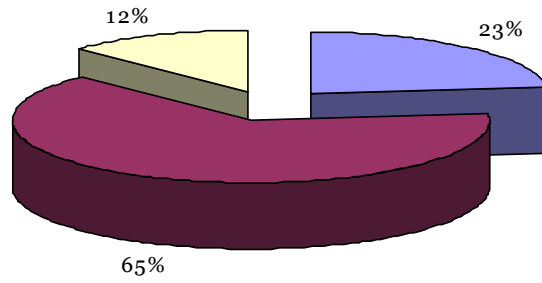

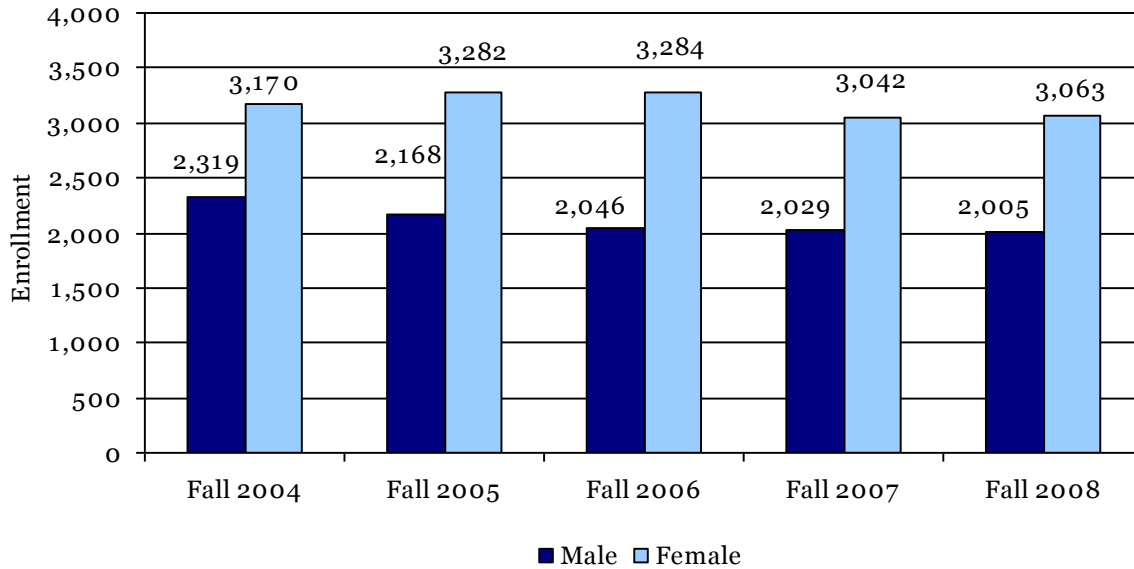


Student Enrollment Enrollment by Gender

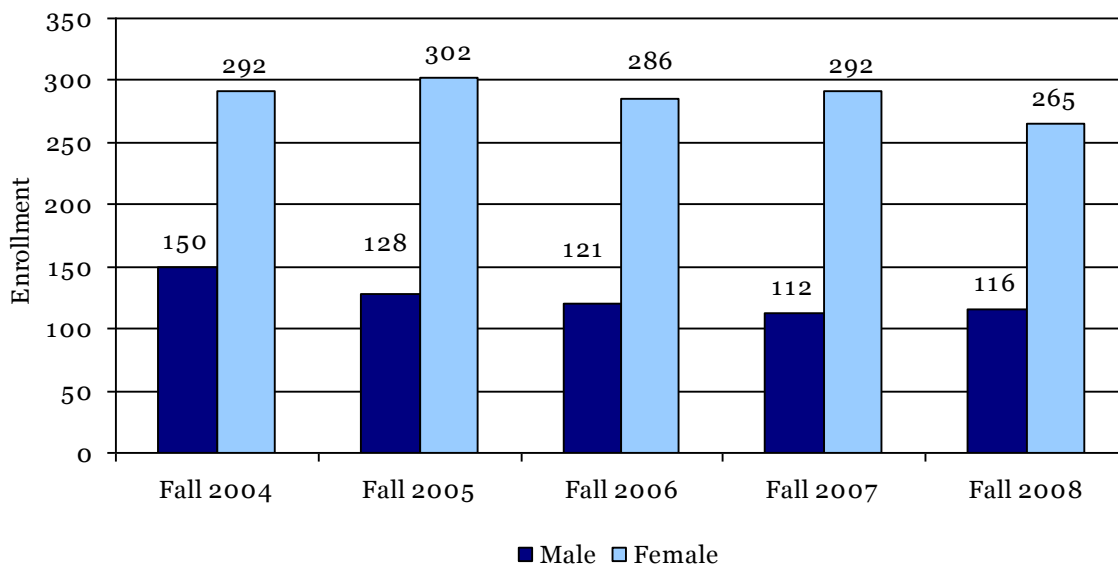

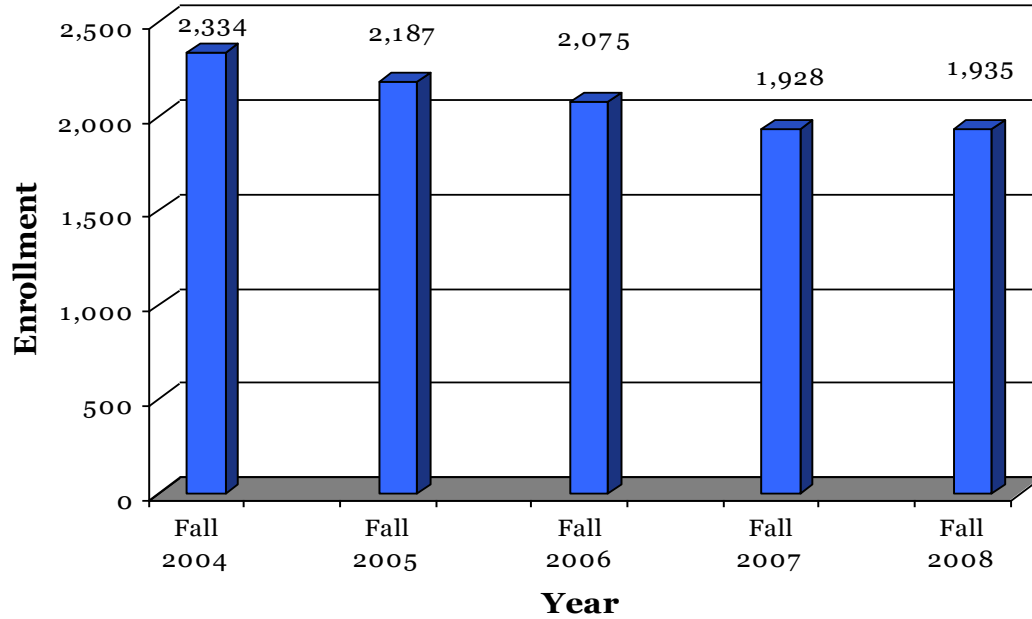


Student Enrollment Fall Enrollment by Classification

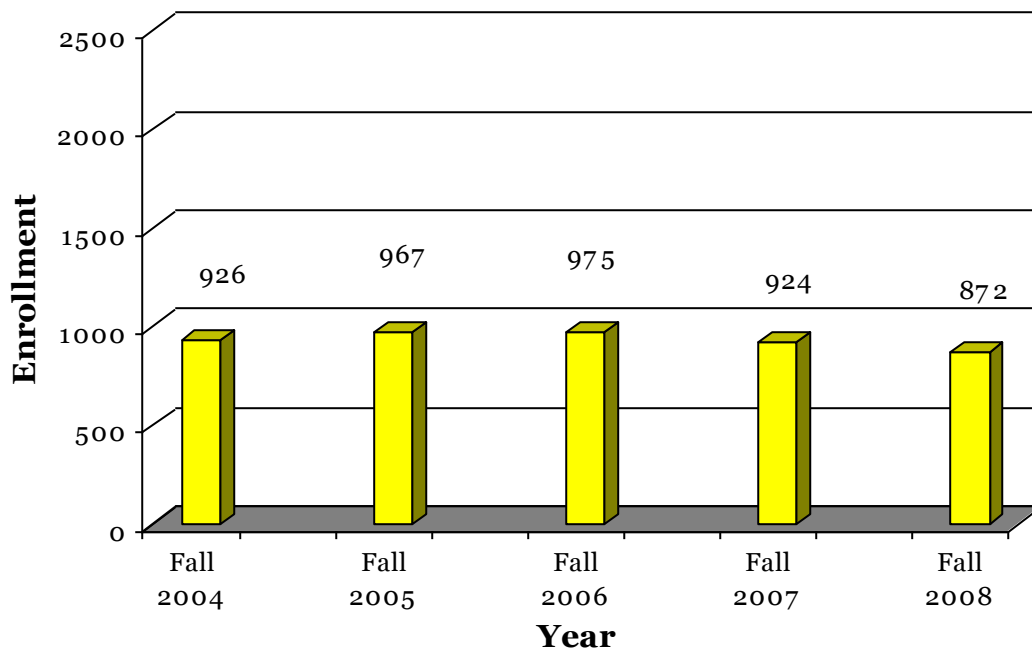

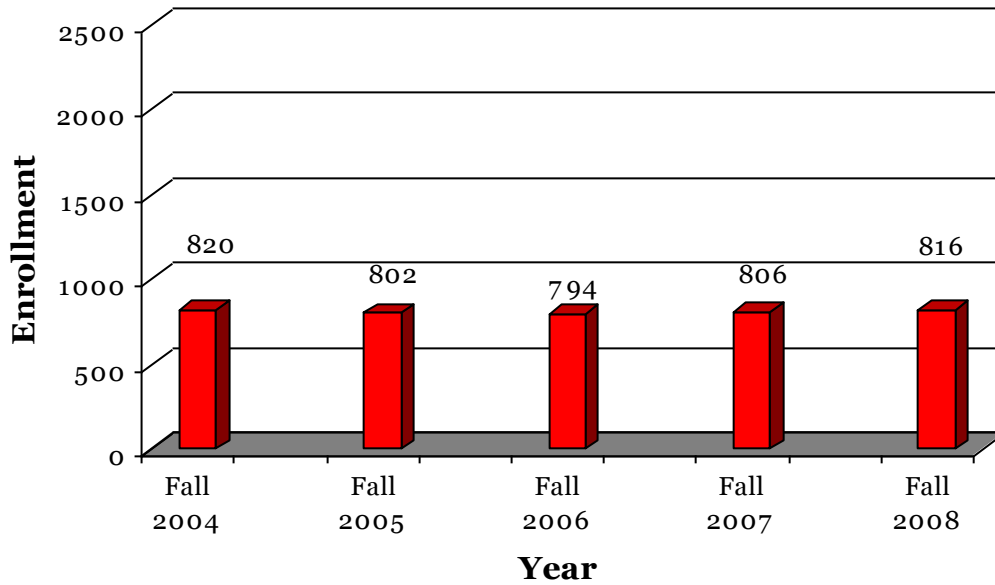


Student Enrollment Fall Enrollment by Classification

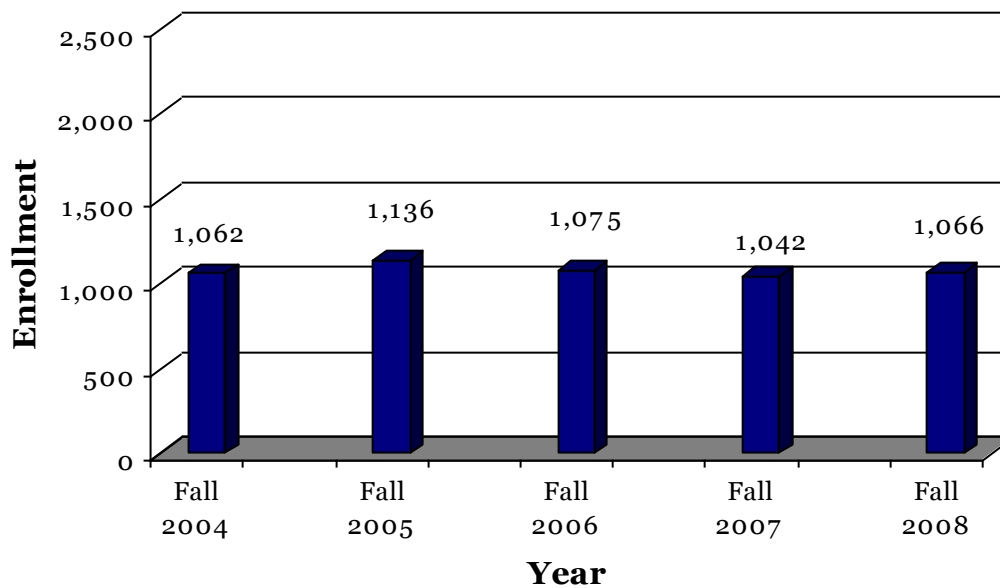

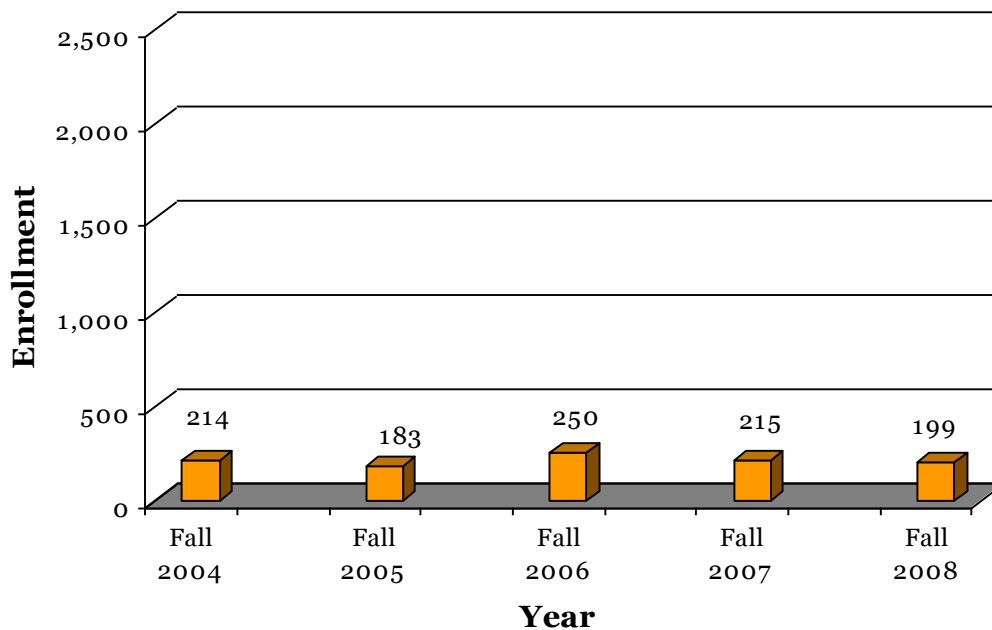


Student Enrollment Fall Enrollment by Classification

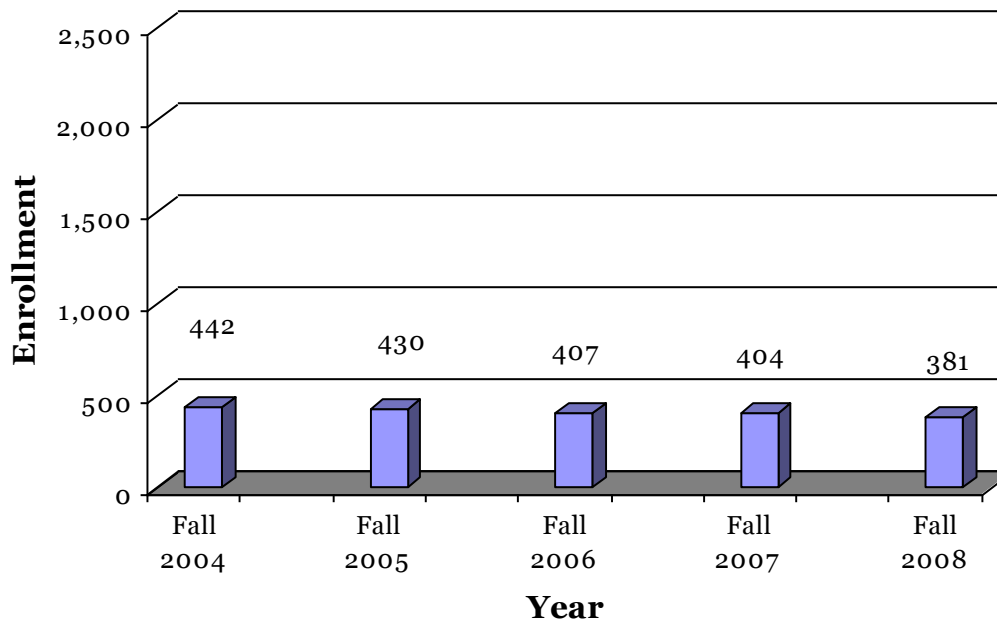

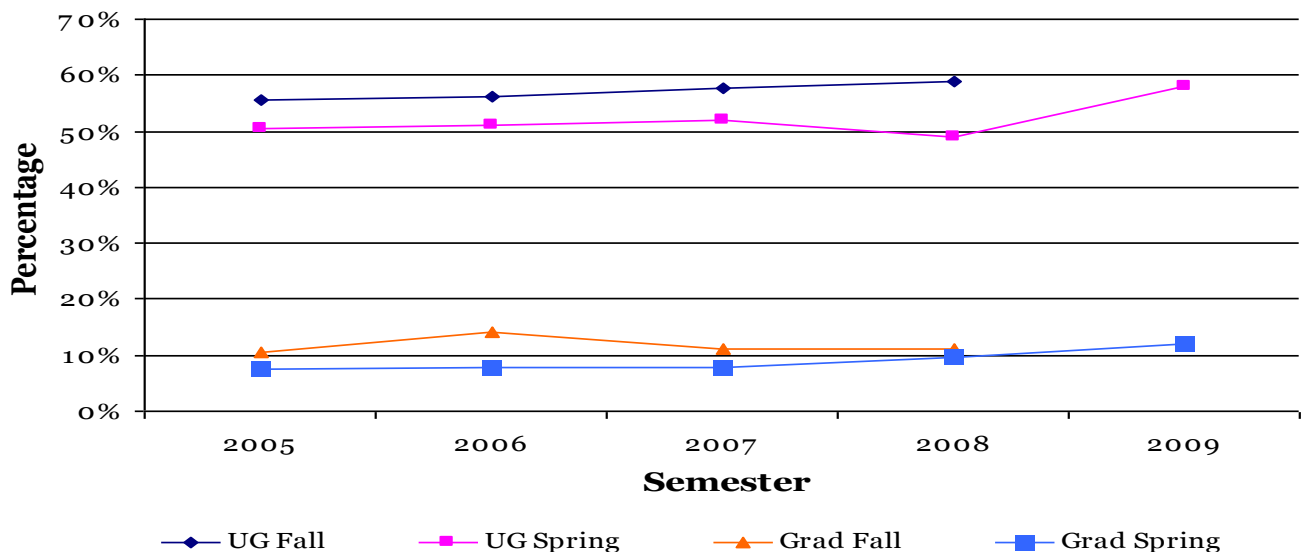

Enrollment by Age Percentage of Students Under 25



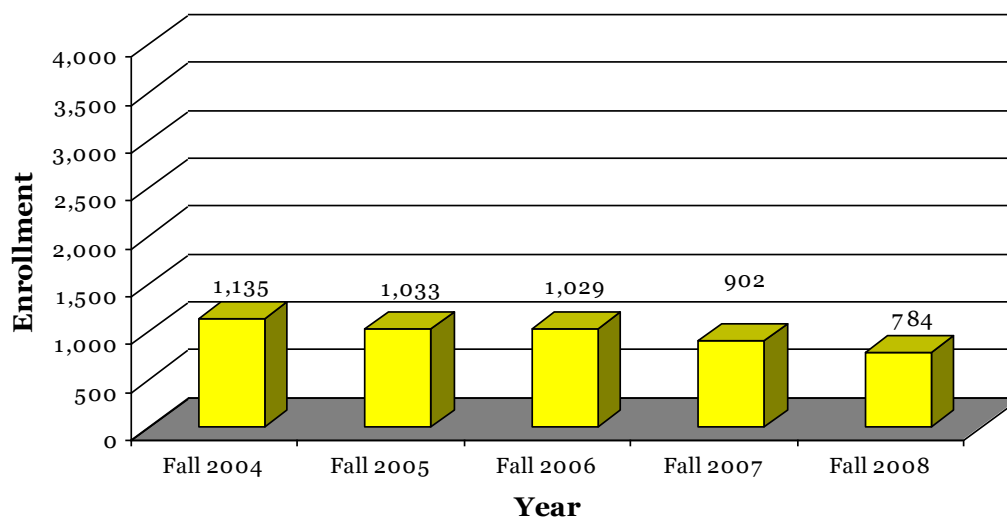


Student Enrollment Fall Undergraduate Enrollment by Ethnicity

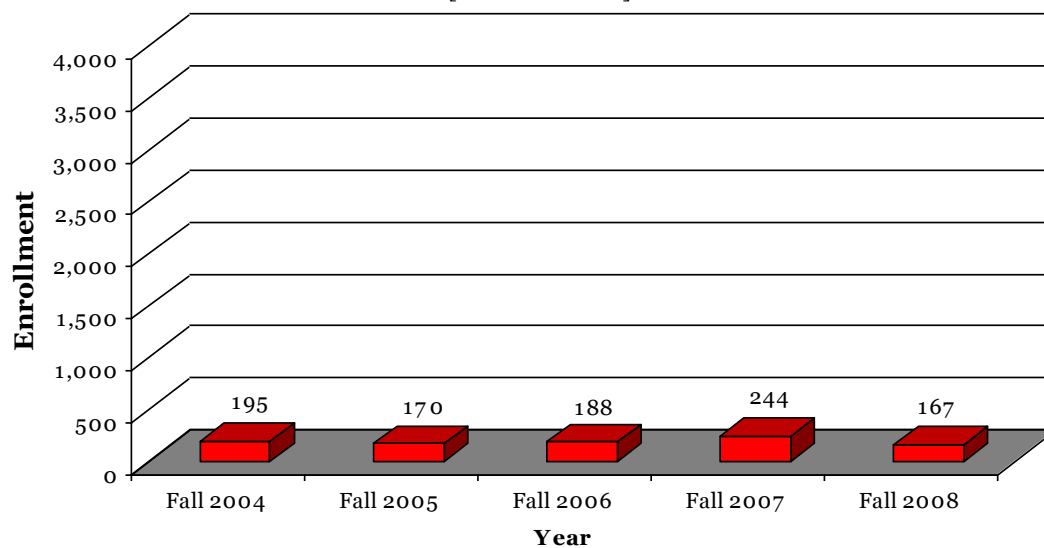

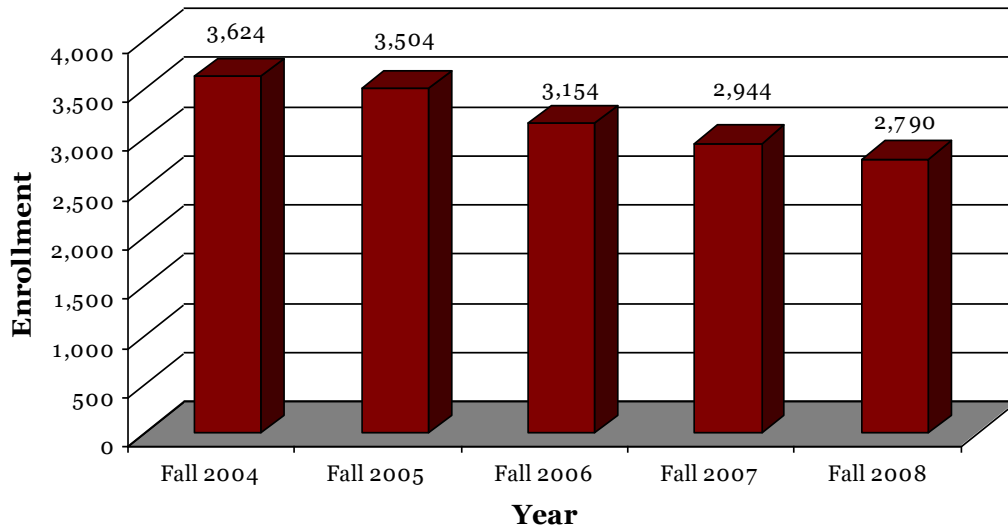


Student Enrollment Fall Undergraduate Enrollment by Ethnicity

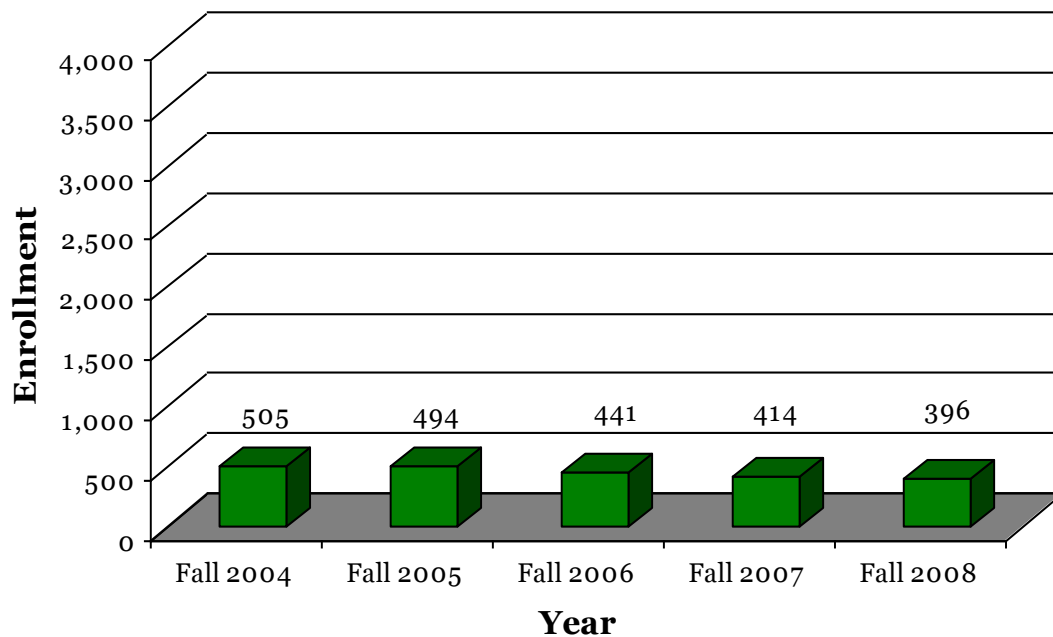

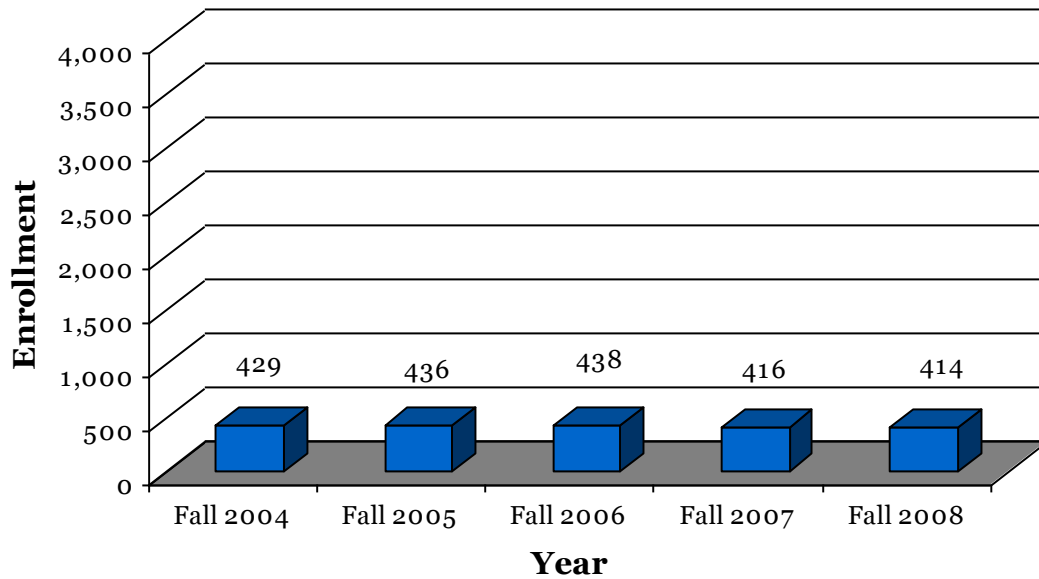




Student Enrollment Fall Undergraduate Enrollment by Ethnicity

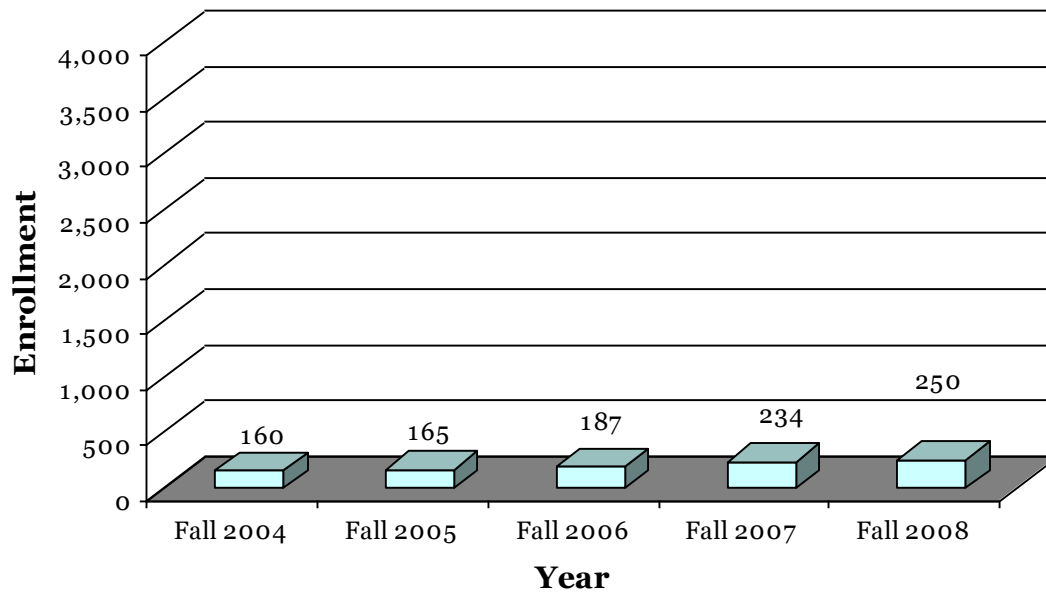
American Indian/ Alaska Native Undergraduate Fall Enrollment by Year

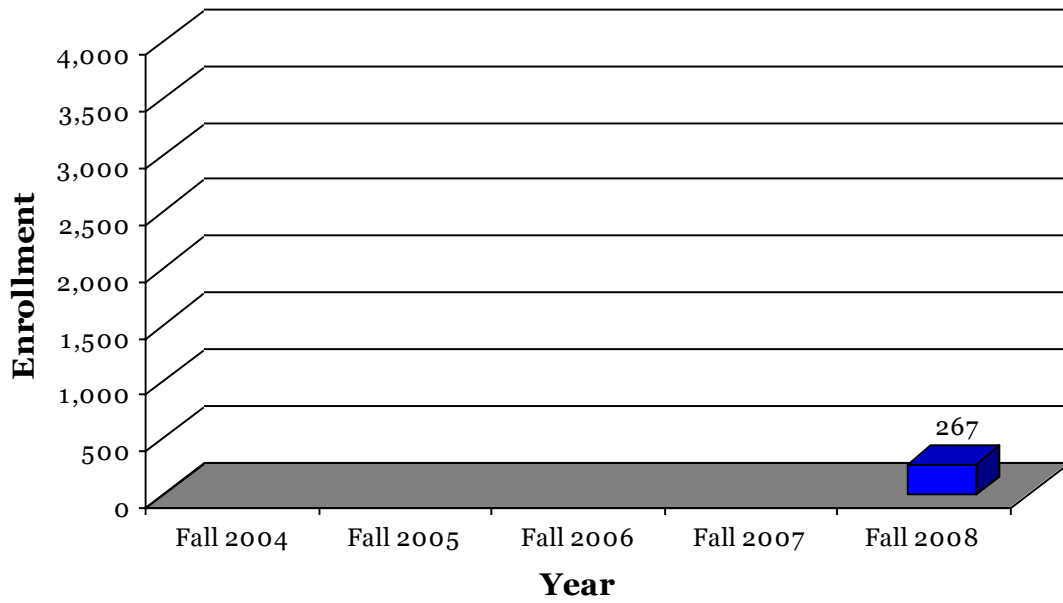


Student Enrollment Fall Undergraduate Enrollment by Ethnicity

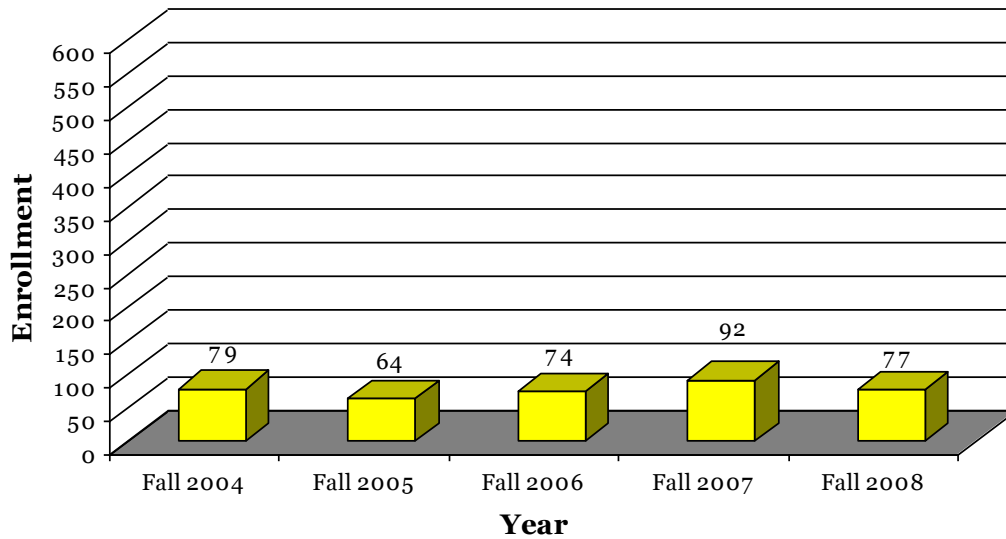


Student Enrollment Fall Graduate Enrollment by Ethnicity

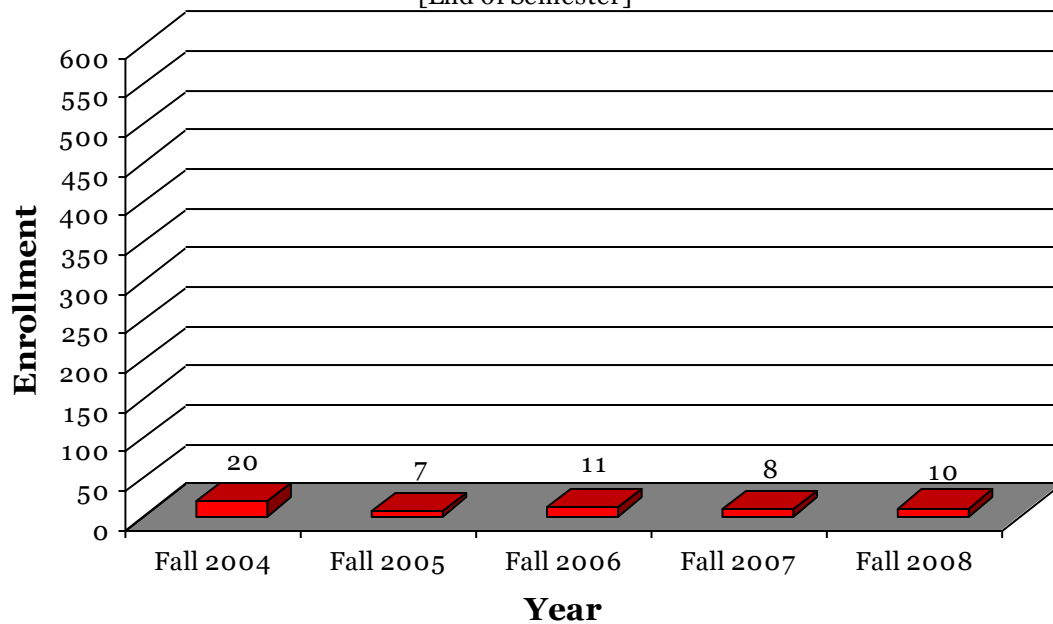

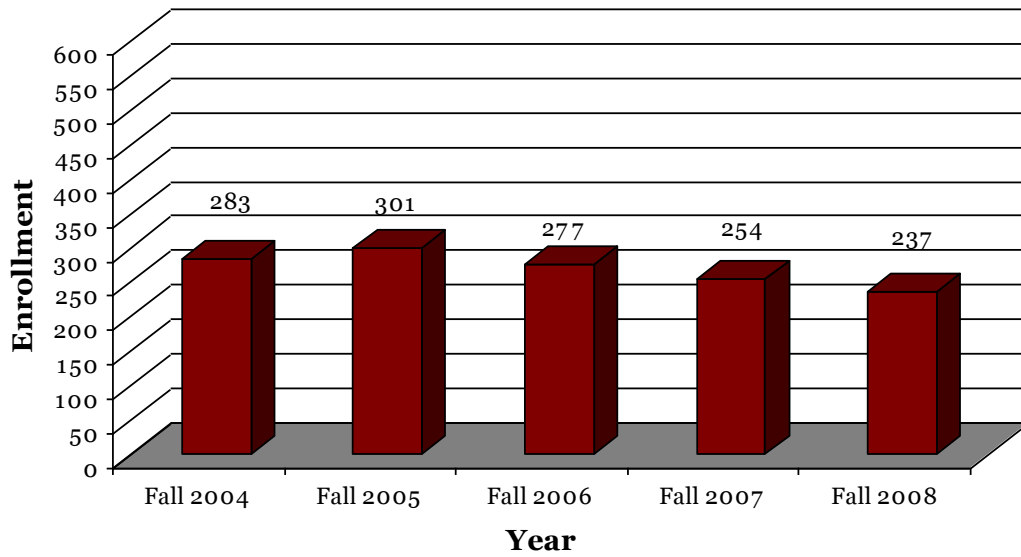




Fall Graduate Enrollment by Ethnicity

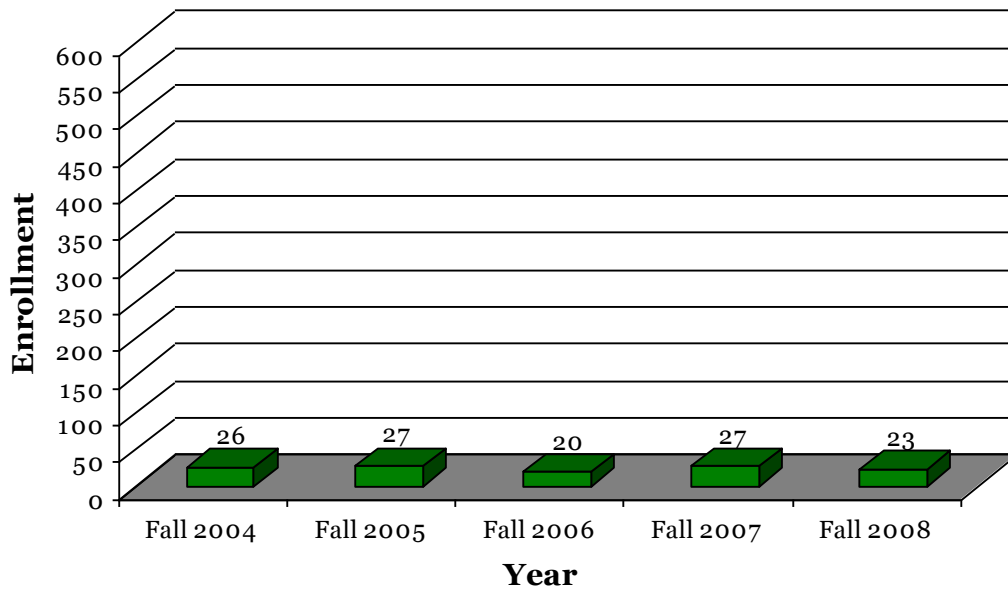
White Graduate Fall Enrollment by Year

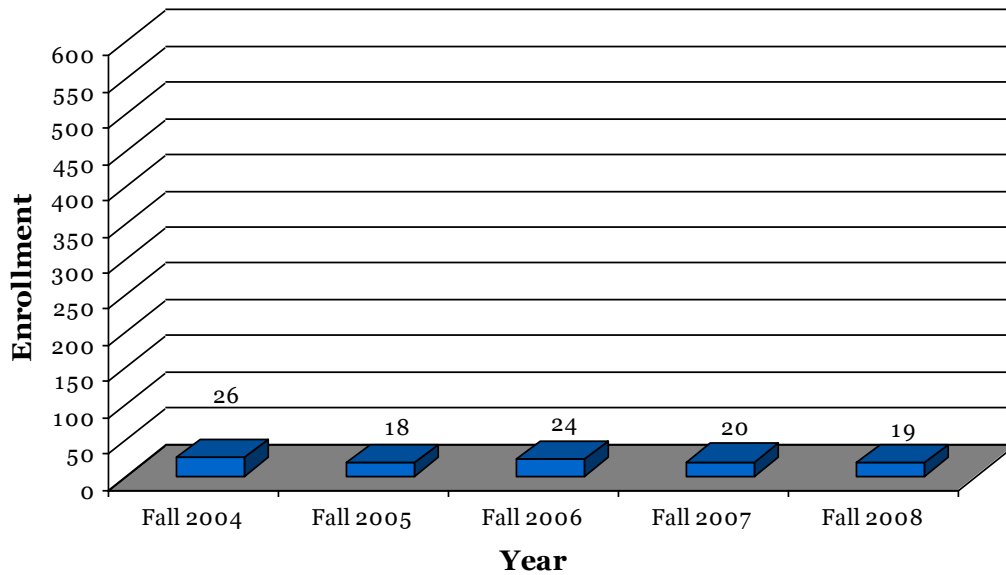




Student Enrollment Fall Graduate Enrollment by Ethnicity

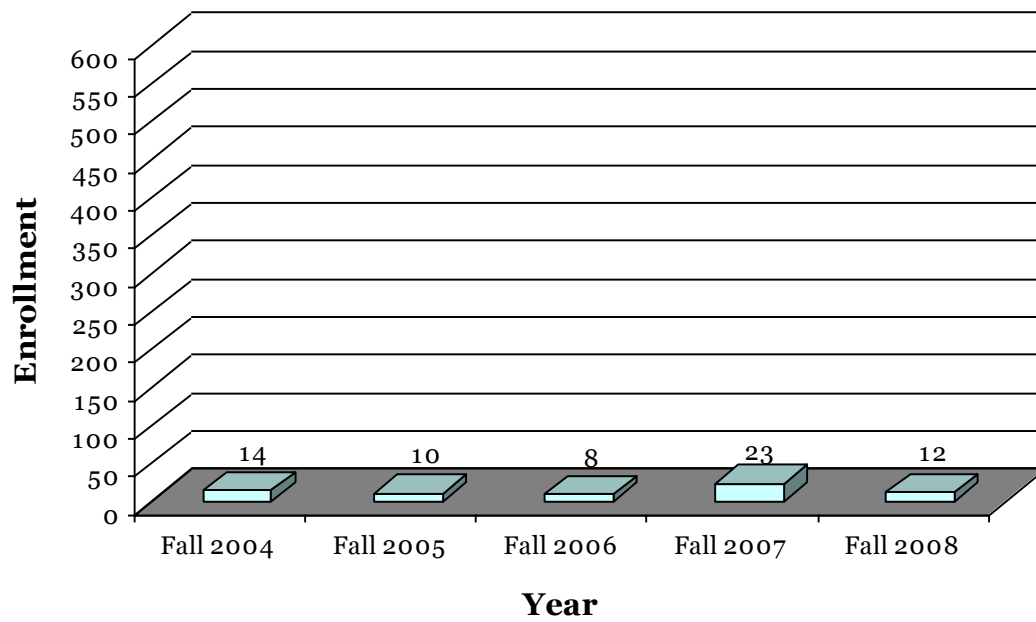
American Indian/ Alaska Native Graduate Fall Enrollment by Year

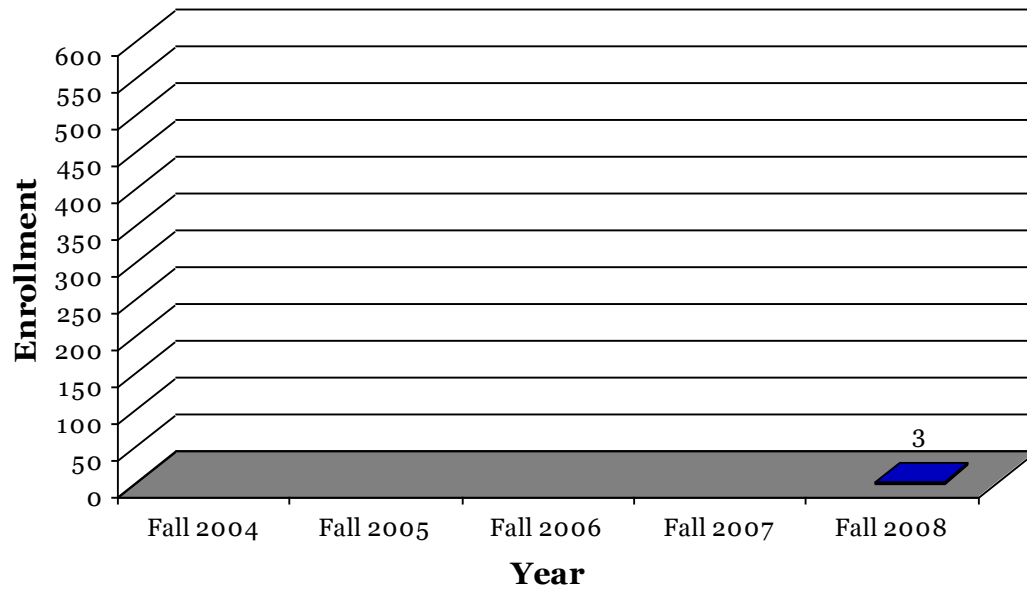


Student Enrollment Fall Graduate Enrollment by Ethnicity

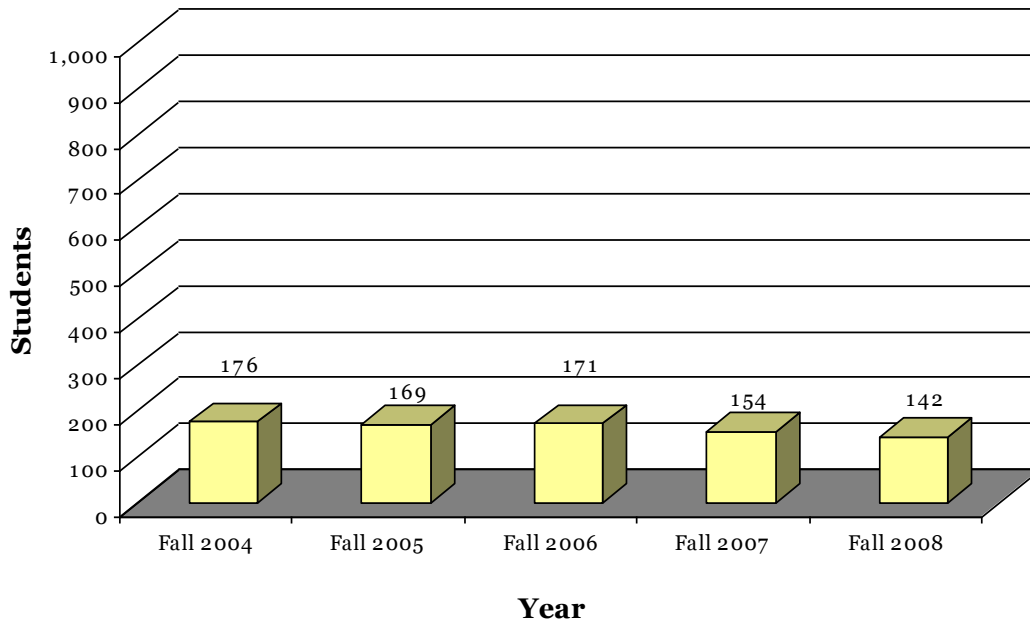


Student Enrollment Major Oklahoma Counties

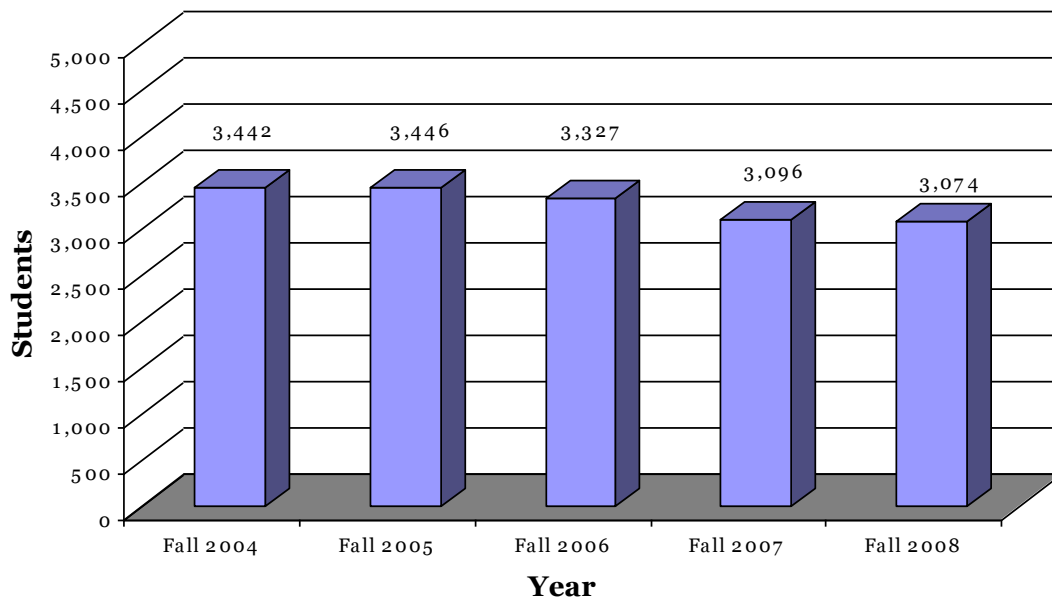

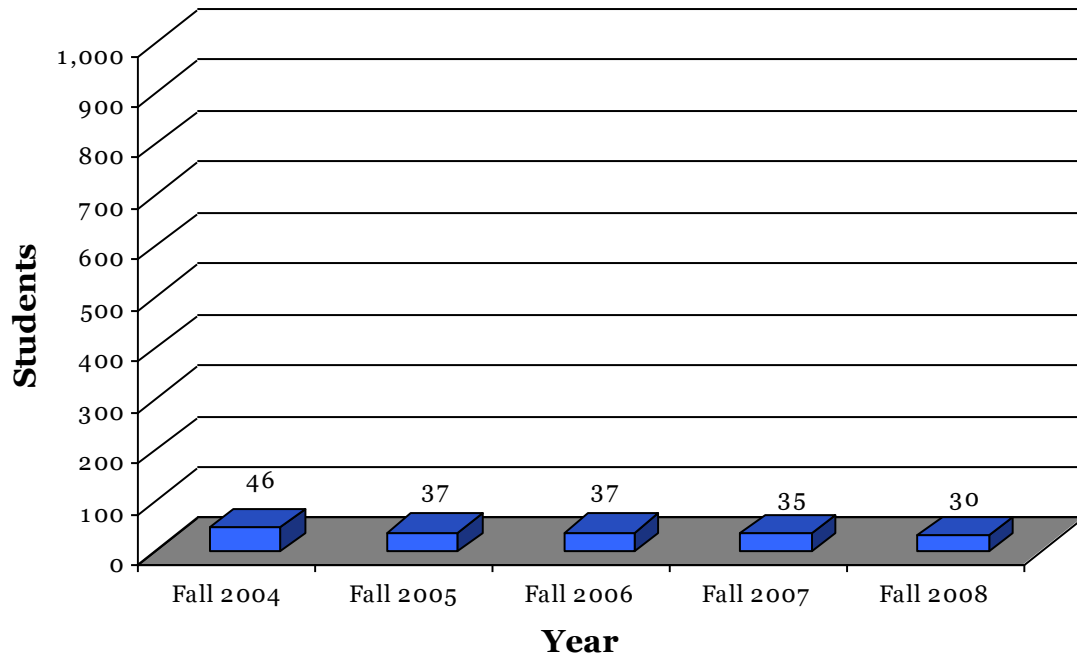


Student Enrollment Major Oklahoma Counties

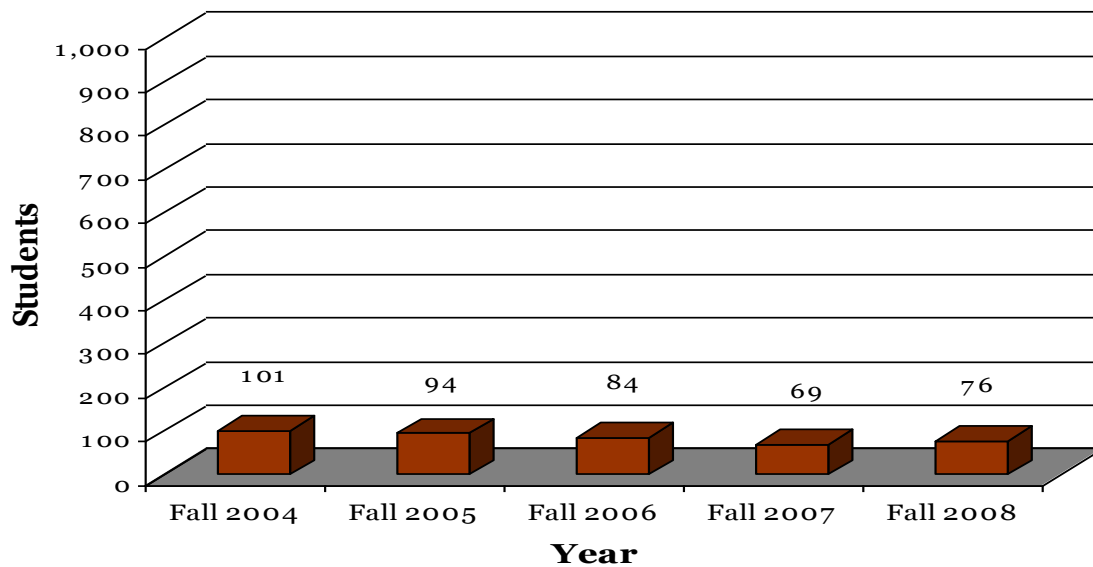

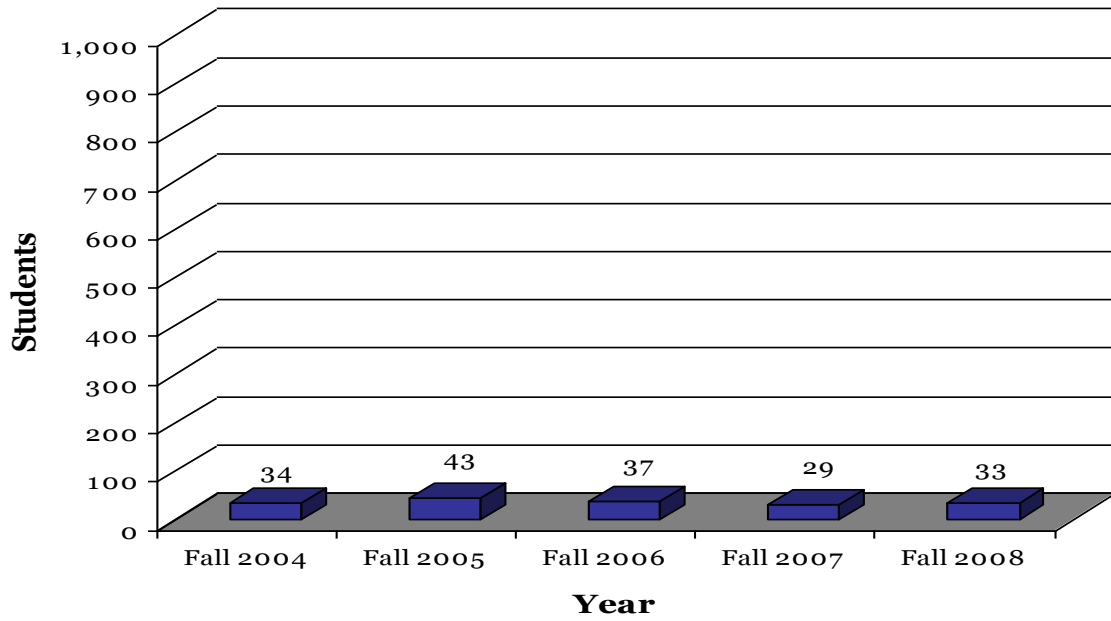




Student Enrollment Major Oklahoma Counties

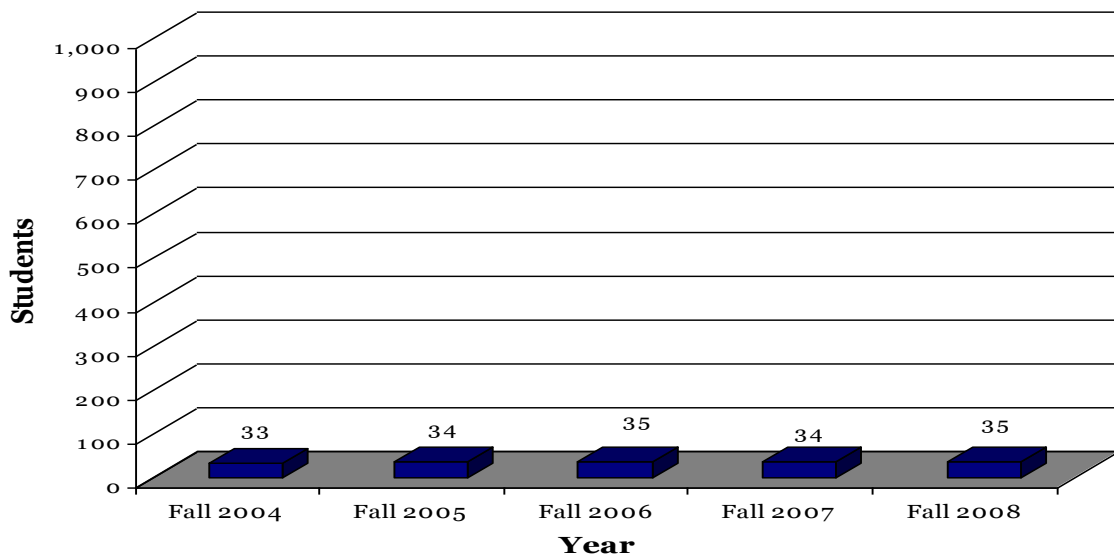

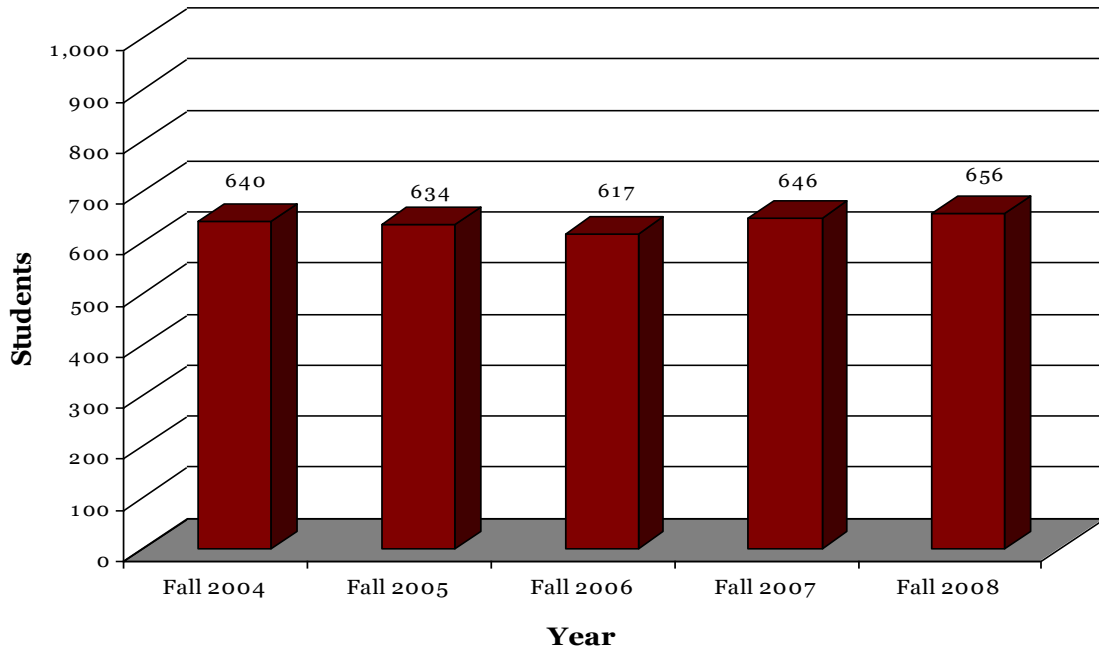

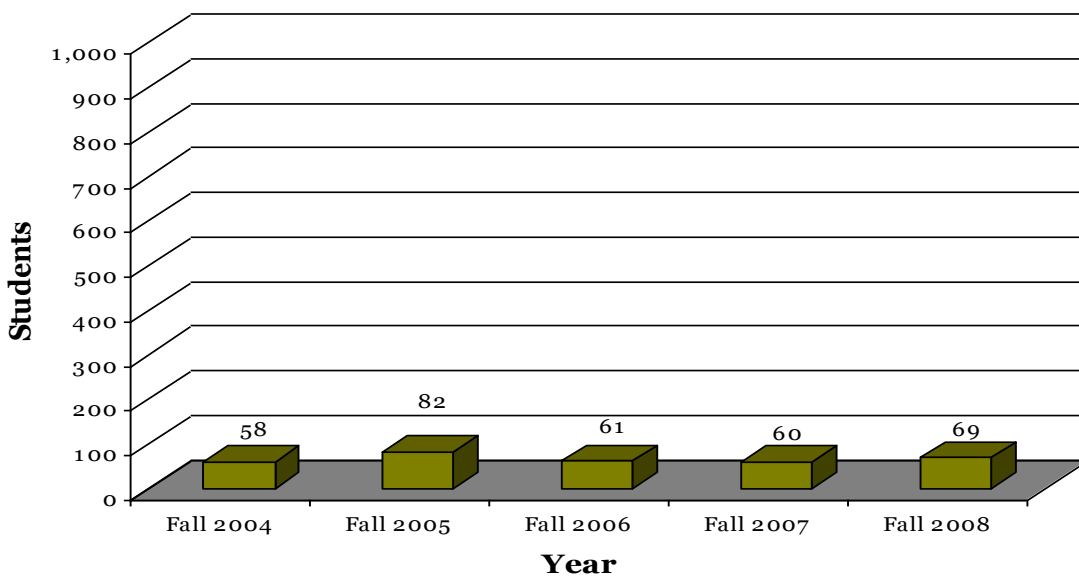

Student Enrollment Grade Point Average

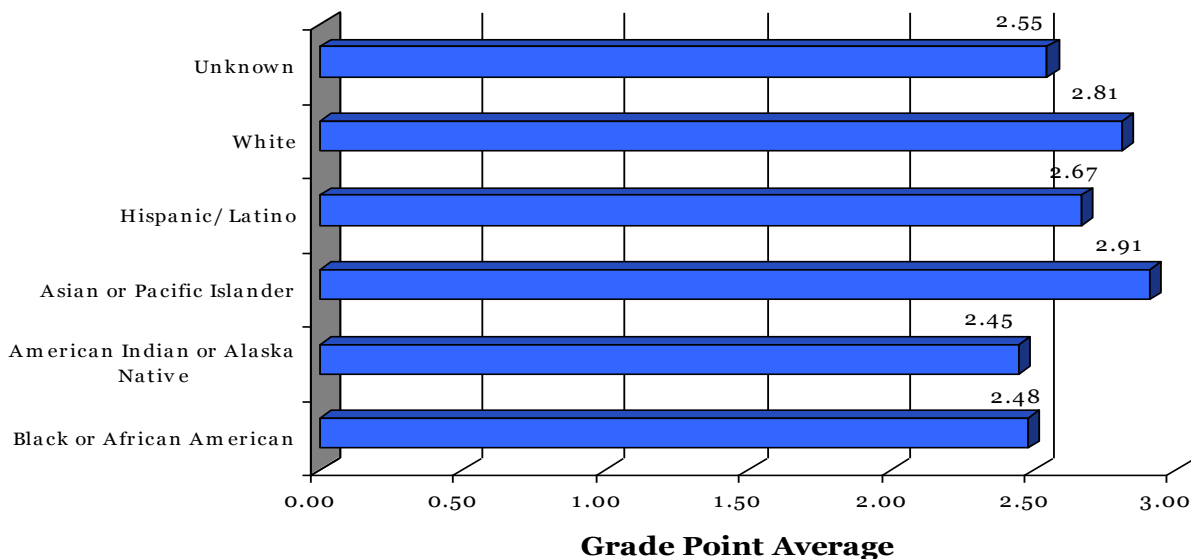

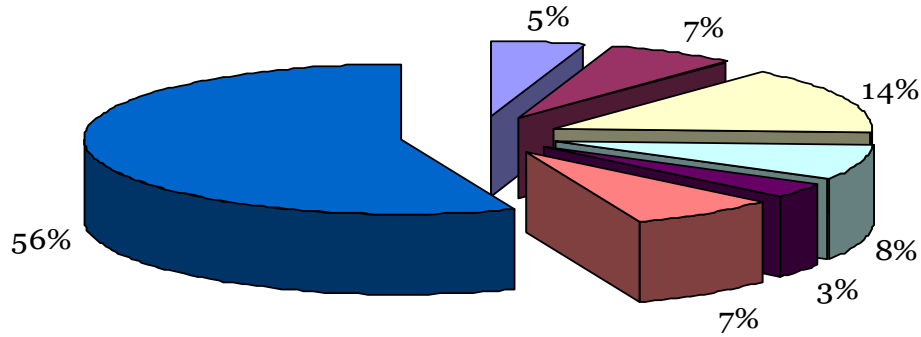


Student Enrollment Fall 2008 Headcount by Educational Goal
