The Department of Education recognizes that special conditions may exist for families who have suffered major reductions in income for various reasons since 2020. For those families, the 2020 tax return does not accurately reflect the current financial status. If your family's income has been significantly reduced, you should complete this form, attach documentation and return it to the Financial Assistance Office for further consideration of your 2022-2023 eligibility for aid. You must be sure to **provide copies of all documentation requested**. Incomplete forms will NOT be evaluated.

B. Explanation of Reduced Income

Provide a typed and signed statement detailing all reasons your family's income has been reduced. Include dates and important details that the specialist may need to know about your situation. The person (student or spouse) whose income changed should be the one that provides the statement. If more than one person's income changed, more than one statement should be submitted.

C. Documentation

Attach the following documentation. **Your request will not be reviewed unless all documentation is submitted. Additional documentation may be requested by the specialist during the review.**

1. Signed statements to support your family's Explanation of Reduced Income. This can include statements from an employer indicating last date of employment, a DD214, a death certificate, letters from counselors, or other third party documentation. **Statements must be on professional letterhead with contact information.**
2. Documentation supporting your family's Expected Income for 2022 listed in Section D (i.e. paystubs, unemployment documentation, etc).
