

TEACH GRANT APPLICATION

Academic Year 2025-2026

The TEACH Grant Program provides funding to students who are completing or plan to complete course work needed to begin a career in teaching. Please submit this completed application to the Office of Financial Assistance **after** you have read details about the grant at https://studentaid.gov/understand-aid/types/grants/teach.

Recipients commit to teaching full-time in a high-need subject area for at least four years within the first eight years of graduation from Cameron. Teaching must occur at a school or educational service agency that serves students from low-income families. The school and agencies must be approved by the U.S. Department of Education.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) each year at www.studentaid.gov
- Complete TEACH Grant Counseling and the Agreement to Serve each year at https://studentaid.gov/teach-grant-program.
- No default status on past student loans.
- Be a U.S. Citizen or eligible non-citizen.
- Maintain a <u>cumulative GPA of 3.25 on a 4.0 scale</u>.
- Be enrolled in one of the following eligible majors at CU:

Early Childhood Education Elementary Education
Mathematics Education Music Education
Social Studies Education English Education
M.Ed. – Reading M.Ed. – Elementary Math

M.Ed. – Special Education M.Ed. - Literacy

If you fail to fulfill your service obligation or if you do not complete your program of study, the grant will be permanently converted to a Federal Direct Unsubsidized Stafford Loan which you will have to repay with interest charged from the date the TEACH Grant was initially disbursed.
