Although primarily academic in nature, other student activities and achievements associated with Cameron University or other regionally or nationally accredited institutions of higher education may be recognized as part of the regalia worn during the ceremonies.

As noted in the Regalia policy, Section 2.4.1.3, Undergraduate degree recipients may wear University-approved ornaments including cords, stoles, and medallions that represent the collegiate experience. Note that as per the policy, civic, corporate, governmental, religious, and pre-collegiate ornaments are prohibited and will not be approved.

All requests for ornament approval must be submitted to the Office of Academic Affairs by **April 15** each year in order to be included on the official listing and worn at Commencement.
